DAY 1 AMSTERDAM

DAY 3 DÜSSELDORF - COLOGNE - KÖNIGSWINTER - KOBLENZ

Our ship will begin to cruise early in the morning to Cologne. Join us on an optional excursion for both packages: Guided tour of Cologne. Our ship will start to cruise up the Rhine to Koblenz. Enjoy a stroll through town to see the famous Deutsches Eck.

DAY 4 KOBLENZ - MAINZ

We'll cruise to Mainz in the early morning, traveling through the magnificent Rhine Valley. We'll arrive in Mainz in the afternoon. It is indeed one of the most beautiful towns on the Romantic Road. In the meantime the ship will cruise on to Bamberg where we will join it. Then, we'll sail on the Rhine-Main-Danube canal all the way to Nuremberg.

DAY 9 NUREMBERG - HIPOLTSTEIN

We'll arrive in Nuremberg. Join us on an optional excursion for both packages: Visit of Nuremberg and tasting of the local specialties, Lebkuchen, the city's famous gingerbread. We'll return to the ship in Hipoltstein and sail on to reach Passau. Enjoy an evening of onboard entertainment.

DAY 10 PASSAU

We'll arrive in Passau in the afternoon. Enjoy some free time to visit the town on your own. Its baroque buildings and narrow romantic streets are unforgettable. Return to ship and sail on to Melk. Enjoy an evening of onboard entertainment.

DAY 11 MELK - DURNSTEIN - VIENNA

We'll arrive in Melk. Join us on an optional excursion for both packages: Visit of the abbey of Melk, perched on a rocky outcrop overlooking the Danube. It is the symbol of Austrian baroque at its finest. We'll return to the ship and sail on to Dürnstein. Enjoy some free time. We'll return on board in the afternoon before sailing on to Vienna. Join us on an optional excursion for both packages: Tour of the illuminated sights of the city by night.

DAY 12 VIENNA - BRATISLAVA

Join us for the optional excursions proposed: **CLASSIC:** Visit to the palace of Schöbrunn with its magnificent park. **DISCOVERY:** The high art of Viennese living: music and Viennese cafes. Tour of the Konzerthaus concert hall(2). We'll cruise towards Bratislava. Join us for the optional excursions proposed: **CLASSIC:** Guided tour of Bratislava. The charm of the Slovakian capital lies in its old city: splendid Baroque palaces, churches and pleasant squares. **DISCOVERY:** Hiking in Bratislava: The Little Carpathians. From Devin Castle,
