
INDOCHINA CRUISE 3 DAYS 2 NIGHTS

DAY 1 Indochina First Day

Our cruise bus will pick you up from your hotel in Hanoi and transfer you to Halong Bay. Upon boarding guests are greeted with a welcome drink and a short cruise briefing. After the briefing and check into our cabins and have free leisure time until lunch on board the cruise.

After lunch we cruise through the Bai Tu Long Bay to visit Cua Van Fishing Village (the largest fishing village on the Bay). Upon arrival at the village, containing over 150 floating houses, guests can choose between kayaking through the village or visiting on small bamboo boats (sampans) rowed by the villagers.

In the afternoon we are back on board the cruise for free leisure time. After that we can join a Cooking Class on board which will be held by our Cruise Chef to learn how make some traditional Vietnamese foods which guests will get taste the food after the class. Next we can enjoy happy hour drinks before a delicious buffet dinner on board.

In the evening you can relax or enjoy on board activities such as: Board games, playing cards, massage services or squid fishing with the crew from the boat. Overnight on Indochina Sails Cruise.

DAY 2 Indochina Second Day

Start your morning with a Tai Chi Lesson before breakfast on board the cruise. After breakfast we will transfer to the Indochina Sails Day Boat, a spacious and comfortable wooden junk with lounge and dining room and a sundeck with lounging furniture. The day's activities include cruising in the Bay for swimming, kayaking at the Bat Cave and a visit to the Pearl Village where there are extensive fish farms and a working pearl processing factory and showroom. Lunch is served on board mid-day.

After lunch we will return to the Indochina Sails main boat at about for free time on board. Enjoy some happy hour drinks before dinner. After dinner guests can enjoy their second evening on the Bay relaxing in the dining room and lounge or on the upper deck and enjoy a second happy hour later in the evening. On board activities for the evening include: Board games, playing cards, massage services or squid fishing with the crew from the boat.

DAY 3 Indochina Last Day

Start your morning with a Tai Chi Lesson before breakfast on board the cruise. After breakfast we disembark our cruise boat for a walking tour of Titov Beach Island. About one hour is spent on the island allowing time for a climb up the steps to the peak for a breathtaking 360-degree view of the Bay (there is also an expansive viewing deck half way up). After the climb there is time left to relax on the beach and have a swim.

After that we will re-board our cruise and check-out of our cabins before it's time for final packing and freshening up before enjoying a full breakfast buffet, including traditional Vietnamese Noodles (Pho). After breakfast you may either relax in the dining room and lounge or on the deck to enjoy the Bay views before you are transferred back to your hotel in Hanoi.
