
PALOMA 3 DAYS 2 NIGHTS

DAY 1 Paloma First Day

Our cruise bus will pick you up from your hotel in Hanoi and transfer you to Halong city. On arrival we will transfer to the Paloma Cruise via our tender boat. After boarding the cruise boat we will have a welcome drink and cruise briefing before checking into our cabins.

After lunch on board head to Bai Tu Long Bay, admiring the fascinating rock formations in the bay. We will then visit the Vung Vieng fishing village by local rowing boat (1 hour) or Kayak into the village. After that, we visit a Pearl Farm to learn how natural pearls are created before returning to our vessel for free time.

That afternoon we will drop anchor near Hang Trong and enjoy the cruise Happy Hour (sunset party). Join a Vietnamese cooking demonstration on board followed by a scrumptious Set-dinner on board.

In the evening, relax in your cabin or join the on board activities including: film entertainment, light music for dancing in the dining room (please book in advance with your tour guide), board games and playing cards, massage services or try your luck at squid fishing from the boat. Overnight on Paloma Cruise.

DAY 2 Paloma Second Day

Start your day with Tai Chi on the Sundeck. This morning we sail through the bay, passing by Trong (Drum) cave, Trinh Nu (Virgin) cave, Coc Ngoi (Toad) Islet before an early breakfast in the dining room.

After breakfast we transfer to a Smaller boat for Lan Ha Bay excursion. Here we enjoy some guided kayaking and swimming at Three Peaches beach before a BBQ lunch is served on beach (depending on the weather or tide levels).

After lunch we visit Toi and Sang Cave (depending on the tide condition), the most remote point in Lan Ha Bay and bordering the Gulf of Tonkin. We will then visit its quaint fishing village and lagoon with the possibility of kayaking through an amazing tunnel under a karst mountain (time permitting).

We then return to the Paloma Cruise for dinner on board as the vessel cruises back to the bay for second overnight anchorage near Ho Dong Tien. Happy hour (Sunset party).

Spend the evening relaxing in your cabin or join the on board activities including: film entertainment, light music for dancing in the dining room (please book in advance with your tour guide), board games and playing cards, the cruise massage services, or try your luck at squid fishing from the boat. Overnight on Paloma Cruise.

DAY 3 Paloma Last Day

Start your day with Tai Chi on the Sundeck before dinner on board the cruise.

After breakfast we transfer by tender to visit the Amazing Cave (Sung Sot Cave).

Amazing Cave is a huge cave consisting of three chambers, which you reach via 90 steps. Among the stalactites of the first hall, scores of gnomes appear to be holding a meeting. The walls of the second chamber sparkle if bright light is shone on them.

We then return to the cruise boat to freshen up and check out of our cabins before enjoying a set Menu for lunch in the dining room.

After lunch you can relax on the sundeck or in the dining room enjoying the bay scenery as we approach the pier. On arrival at Hon Gai Harbor we transfer by tender to the pier and relax inside the Paloma Office before our cruise bus transfers you back to Hanoi around 4.30pm.
