## DAY 1 SIEM REAP ARRIVAL (D)

On your arrival at Siem Reap's International Airport, you will be welcomed and transferred to your hotel. In the afternoon, after a trip briefing, then enjoy a Welcome Dinner.

## DAY 2 ANGKOR WAT TOUR (B,L)

On your arrival at Noi Bai's International Airport, you will be welcomed and transferred to your hotel. In the afternoon, enjoy the iconic cyclo tour around the Old Quarter. Have your first glimpse of Hanoi, then enjoy a Dinner.4

## DAY 4 HANOI - EMBARK HALONG BAY CRUISE (B,L,D)

Today, you will be transferred to Haiphong City and embark on your luxury 5\* Era Cruise to discover the Halong Bay.

## DAY 5 HALONG BAY (B,L,D)

Optional electric car service is available (at an extra cost).

After lunch, enjoy your free time kayaking and swimming at Ba Ham Lake area situated in the middle of a narrow, rectangular area, with all four sides enclosed by vertical cliffs (if the weather permits). ## DAY 6 DISEMBARK ERA CRUISE - HANOI (B,L)

In the morning, practice Tai Chi onboard. Relax with an early morning cup of tea, coffee or juice anywhere you wish on the boat and watch the never ending miraculous scenery unfold before you. #### DAY 7 HANOI – LUANG PRABANG – EMBARK MEKONG CRUISE (B,D)

In the evening, you can take a stroll along the Mekong promenade or visit the colorful Hmong night market. You have time to enjoy the ship's spacious decks and lounge before attending your welcome reception and dinner. A selection of Asian and European food is provided throughout the cruise.

#### DAY 8 LUANG PRABANG AND KUANG SI FALLS (B,L,D)

After breakfast on board, you explore the city on a half-day excursion, beginning with the famous Wat Xieng Thong temple and the National Museum of Luang Prabang. You enjoy the city's unique architectural style, which is a blend of Buddhist temples and monasteries with French colonial buildings.

During lunch on board, your vessel starts cruising downstream. An afternoon tuk-tuk excursion takes you to the Kuang Si Falls, one of the most gorgeous waterfalls in Laos.

## DAY 9 PAK OU CAVES (B,L,D)

After a relaxing morning on board, you stop at the famous Pak Ou Caves, populated by thousands of Buddha statues of all shapes and sizes. From there, you can go on a short jungle trek through the forest to a small riverside village and visit the village distillery. Alternatively, you can reach the village comfortably by boat. That afternoon, you continue cruising upstream towards Oudomxay Province.

## DAY 10 THE MIGHTY MEKONG (B,L,D)

The river traffic thins out as you proceed upstream, where you enjoy fantastic landscapes along the river. You relax on deck, in your comfortable cabin or in the lounge and soak up the scenery as the landscape becomes more and more spectacular—hills covered with tropical vegetation, awe-inspiring rock formations along the riverbanks, and a diverse array of rapid currents and slow rivulets. The power of the mighty Mekong will give your cruise the feeling of a real expedition.

## DAY 11 RELAXATION & VILLAGE LIFE (B,L,D)

Today is a day to take it all in—the diversity of the landscape astonishes you as tropical hills emerge in the distance. You enjoy the tranquility of northern Laos, a real retreat from the hustle-and-bustle of life back home.

As you cruise past green hillsides, you start heading upstream toward Pak Tha. In the evening, you enjoy our barbecue dinner in a beautiful riverside location.

## DAY 12 PAK THA & HUAY XAY (B,L,D)

At Pak Tha, a small village, you take off on a long-tail boat excursion on the Namtha River to visit a Khmu village. The small village school has been supported by donations from guests for many years. The purely natural landscape is only broken by seldom sights of small villages and herds of cattle.

In the afternoon, you proceed to the Thailand–Laos border at Chiang Khong, Thailand, and Huay Xay, Laos. That evening, you relax and enjoy your final delicious dinner in Laos.

## DAY 13 THE GOLDEN TRIANGLE (B,L,D)

Today you go on an excursion to the Golden Triangle area at Chiang Saen, where you visit the Golden Buddha of Sop Ruak and the Hall of Opium Museum. This fascinating museum, sponsored by the royal family of Thailand, gives a deep background on the history and politics of the opium trade and the health effects of opium abuse. Your last evening onboard is celebrated with a farewell dinner.

## DAY 14 FAREWELL - DISEMBARK CRUISE - CHANG RAI AIRPORT (B)

After breakfast you say goodbye to your Laotian crew. Later you check out and disembark from your boutique ship, taking with you a treasure chest of memories.
